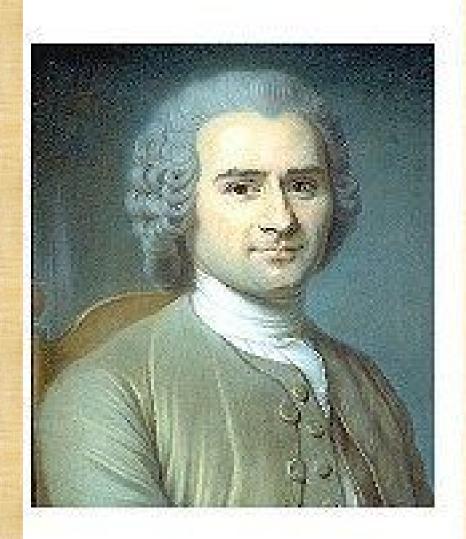



## Rousseau Jean Jacques 1712 – 1778



- Geneva, Maverick, on the run
- Pantheon in Paris (1794)
- State of nature as normative guide, critique of society, civilization as decadent
- Fault of ownership x savage
- Morality as natural, innate
- Instinct/emotions as its source
- Marxism, romantics, environmentalism ...

## French revolution 1789

- Declaration of Independence 1776
- Declaration of the Rights of Man and of Citizens 1789 (Lafayette, Sieyés, Mirabeau)
- Declaration of the Rights of Woman and of the Female Citizens (Olympe de Gouge)
- Napoleon: Code Civil 1804
- Habsburgs: ABGB 1811
  - Codex Maximilianeus Bavaricus Civilis, 1756
  - Universal Delaration of Human Rights 1948
