• 1 carat —2,500 — 18,000\$




Main problems

- Interpol most wanted list

Are most of the diamonds on the market bloody?

- Price depends from which zone it is mined
- Diamonds are also part of black market
- In 80's 21% of diamonds were sold through black market



Kimberley process


- Industry influencing the flow of blood diamonds
- Gorvernment-led certification scheme
- Applies only on the rough diamonds to get into international Market





- Oil production plays key role in Libyan civil war
- Is oil conflict just impact of Civil war and acts done by Gadaffi?
- LNA and other factions are using Oil for setting up their demands
- Rebel groups are making Oil blockades causing 80% Lybia economy drop
